## Wrapped up for Christmas



Roehampton Lane is a development of 31 flats being constructed by Kingsbury Construction Company for One Housing Group. The scheme set within the Roehampton Conservation Area uses both the local vernacular and the topography of the site to inform the design. The proposal incorporates four disabled units on the ground floor all with private amenity space and a large first

floor communal garden.

The scheme has been constructed using a concrete frame and light gauge steel, prior to the start of construction the 3m high retaining wall needed to be further reinforced. The scheme has been made water tight and is due to complete for April 2015.

## Jingle Bells



Bell Lane, Hounslow is a town centre site providing 134 mixed tenure dwellings above retail opportunities, for A2 Dominion Housing Association. A planning application is being submitted this month, we have worked closely with the council to establish the 11 storey massing.

## Star from the East



Ashington East, Bethnal Green for Tower Hamlet Homes has been submitted for a planning application. The development creates 53 dwellings either side of an existing building, the scheme also provides a new home for Collingwood Community Centre and a children's play area.
