That Approval Rocks!



This month we received a unanimous approval of a mixed use tower located on Rockingham Street, Elephant and Castle, adjacent to a railway viaduct. The scheme for Landcorp Ltd (London), provides thirty residential units spread over thirteen storeys with the existing ground floor and basement restaurant usage retained.

The proposed aesthetics of the building features a modern brick design with high quality brickwork in varying shades of grey with deep window reveals and narrow shadow gaps.

A semi-enclosed double height private amenity space will sit at the top of the building.

Almost Settled!

It won't be long till the dust settles at Dockland Settlements and the scheme is handed over to the trust and to Family Mosaic. The development accommodates mixed tenure houses, flats and a new home for the Dockland settlements No.4 and Odessa Street Youth Centre, providing space and facilities for the local community, including a children's play area and a new sports pitch.
